Entry Fee: The entry fee for this tournament is \$35.00 for members and \$45 for guests. Entry fees must be paid by April 8, 2009 either by mail to KHMC at Post Office Box 1573, Redondo Beach, CA 90278 or in person at the April 8th General Meeting. If mailed in PLEASE also fax a copy of the Entry Form to Don Butts at (310) 378-0366. It is the Team Captain's responsibility to insure that all members of their team have paid entry fees and are properly entered in the tournament. Guest anglers are welcome as long as they fish on a member's boat. **All members' dues must be paid in order to enter. No Exceptions.**

April General Meeting will be on April 8th at the Redondo Beach Yacht Club at 7:00 PM.

Rules and Regulations: Anglers must comply with all KHMC and IGFA fishing rules and DFG regulations. Short fish will disqualify the angler and all his/her fish. More than one single hook may be used, but double or treble hooks are prohibited. Fishing is restricted to the area between Point Dume and the Mexican Border and not further than 100 miles offshore. The tournament will take place on the specified dates regardless of weather or sea conditions.

Fishing times are from 6:00am Saturday to "lines out" at 4:30pm on Sunday. Fish must be weighed with a certified scale no later than 8pm Sunday. Each fish being weighed must have an "official weigh-slip". Each weigh-slip must include the following information: angler, boat name, date of catch, time of catch, time of weigh-in, line class, approximate location of catch and weight of fish. Weigh-slips must be signed by a non-team member witness. All weigh slips must be faxed to Don Butts at (310) 378-0366 within 24 hours of "lines out" to qualify and must include a contact number for the Team Captain.

1st tie breaker is line test, 2nd tie breaker is first fish weighed.

The prizes listed below are based on both days of fishing. Gift certificates will be issued after the tournament. Plaques and the Perpetual Trophy will be awarded at the January Awards Dinner. Good luck and have fun!
